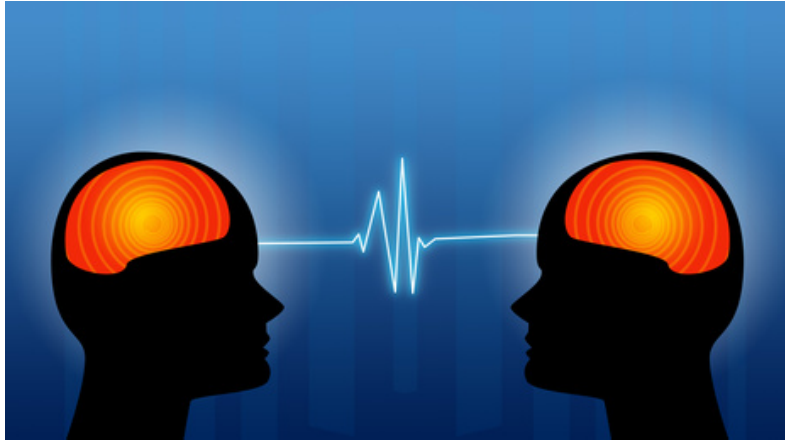
9. Tacit: Indicated but not expressed; implied silently.
